

Call for Papers:

Challenges for Agri-Food Supply Networks. New Forms of Collaborations in the context of COVID-19

For the November IFAMA-WICaNeM conference, the organizers invite participants to discuss and share their vision on **how COVID-19** is impacting agri-food supply networks, now and in the future.

Submissions to the conference are encouraged to fall within, but are not limited to the following questions:

- What is the impact of a pandemic such as the one caused by the COVID-19, and containment measures, on existing agri-food supply chains?
- How will COVID-19 and subsequent measures impact international trade in specific foods, seeds, and flowers; will existing and new trade and non-trade (e.g. phytosanitary) barriers be imposed?
- How COVID-19-proof and resilient are agri-food networks? Are new knowledge and new collaborations needed in reforming agri-food to deliver sustainable and resilient development?
- What strategies of agribusinesses, regulators and governments are emerging and will emerge in the (post-) COVID-19 era and how successful those could be?
-) How the novel coronavirus, and containment measures set by the governments impact multifunctional agriculture?
- How does COVID-19 affect the performance of agri-food supply chains and their contribution to attaining sustainable development goals?
- What are the outlook for agri-food supply networks during and post-pandemic?
-) How is the interplay between stakeholders within and between agri-food supply networks changing?

Next to this, it is also possible to submit a proposal for an 'open session' including academic, business or other stakeholders from different corners of agri-food networks (combinations are preferred). There will also be an opportunity for poster presentations.
